



## ICADE SANTÉ AND SAINT-GOBAIN GLASS PIONEER THE USE OF LOW-CARBON GLASS AT LE PARC POLYCLINIC IN CAEN

For the first time in France, Icade Santé and Saint-Gobain Glass will install a range of glass with the lowest carbon footprint on the market (7 kg CO<sub>2</sub> eq/sq.m) at Le Parc polyclinic operated by the Elsan Group in Caen (Calvados).



This industry first was achieved through a production process that uses renewable energy and results in a high recycled glass content (c. 70% cullet). This innovation will significantly reduce the carbon footprint associated with renovating Le Parc polyclinic's joinery and will speed up the growth of the circular economy.

The new low-carbon COOL-LITE® XTREME range developed by Saint-Gobain Glass will have the lowest carbon footprint on the market, i.e. around 40% lower than the European average for its products. With façades accounting for up to 20% of the carbon footprint of buildings, this new range will make a major contribution to reducing their environmental impact.

Covering around 21,000 sq.m, Le Parc polyclinic is an acute care facility operated by the Elsan Group in Caen with 228 beds and places. The facility performs key surgical procedures in orthopaedics, urology, gastroenterology and gynaecology, in addition to providing oncology and nuclear medicine services.

This renovation project is fully in line with Icade Santé's energy renovation plan which aims to reduce the carbon intensity of its buildings by 37% by 2030<sup>1</sup>.
